**Facts about Borobudur**

Largest Buddhist temple complex: Borobudur is the largest Buddhist temple complexes in the world and is located on the Indonesian island of Java.

- UNESCO World Heritage since 1991.
- It was built in the 8th century by the Shailendra dynasty and is considered the most important structure of Mahayana Buddhism.
- The complex has a shape of a huge pyramid and consists of more than 2 million stone blocks. The Stupa is 9 stories high and rises about 40 metres.
- Regulation Borobudur to enjoy the sunrise over Bukit Dagi or Putuk Situmbu.
